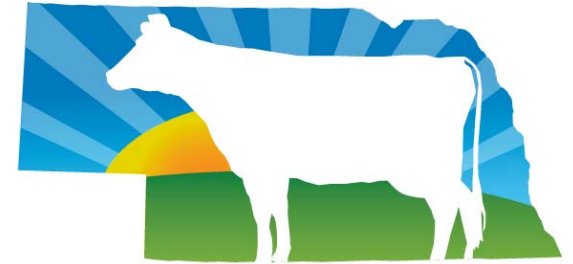

# Why Join NSDA?

In 2010 the Nebraska State Dairy Association is celebrating 125 Years of organization. The NSDA is the sole voice of Nebraska’s Dairy Producers when it comes to the legislative arena and representing issues related to Growth and Development of the dairy industry. Producer memberships are \$25 per year, truly a small price for what the organization offers each of its members.

The NSDA is made up of an elected board along with committees focused on membership, convention/education, awards, legislation, and growth and development. In 2009-10 a special committee was formed to work with the Nebraska Cattlemen on Dairy Beef Quality Assurance.

Members are communicated with through bi-annual newsletters, email blasts and the [www.nebraskamilk.org](http://www.nebraskamilk.org) website.

## Legislation

In 2009 and 2010 the NSDA worked with fellow commodity groups on LB 865, Nebraska’s Animal Cruelty Law. In the Fall of 2009 during the Special Session, members contacted State Senators against the budget shortfall suggestion of taking state Checkoff funds for the general budget. Members

have hosted an Ag Day luncheon the past 2 years with Nebraska State Senators and staff to bring attention to agriculture and dairy industry issues. Animal well-being, DEQ zoning and tax rights are focus areas.

## Convention/Education

Annually the NSDA has provided a Statewide Dairy Convention. This day and half event brings together producers and industry partners and features a trade show, educational seminars, tours, snacks, association and board meetings, and an awards banquet. This event is offered FREE to producer members and their families. A goal of the NSDA is to eventually offer producers and/or youth educational support in the form of scholarships.

## Awards

Each year the NSDA presents the Philip H. Cole Distinguished and Young Dairyman awards along with recognizing Nebraska producers for top Milk Quality and DHIA Production.

## Growth & Development

Producers and fellow Nebraska commodity groups remain active in helping Nebraska producers expand their operations along with working to attract new producers in Nebraska to grow/maintain our dairy industry.
